
Spring Grove Baseball Association

President's Report, submitted by Jon Kilmer:

- o January meeting minutes approved by all.
- o Treasurer's Report approved by all.

Vice-President's Report, submitted by Mike Frey:

- There is a late registration for 8UC. Mike will reach out to the family.
- o There is an organizational gamechanger account that can be setup for 8UA and up.

 - SGBA would like to know more information before submitting a donation like what is the timeline? Is softball donating and if so, how much? SGBA will decide at the end of the year on a dollar amount.

Secretary's Report, submitted by Jennifer Sipe:

- o Banking information still needs to be updated. Waiting to hear back from Wanda with paperwork to sign.
- o Scholarship applications should be given to coaches of seniors once teams are formed.
- Winter workouts signup sheets for March need to be redone with the date/time changes.
- o A form will be sent out to all head coaches 8U-12U for assistant coach, scorekeeper, shirt/hat sizes.
- Working on getting all necessary paperwork completed for small games of chance renewal.



Equipment Director, submitted by Tim Hunter:

- o Tim is still evaluating the catcher's gear
- o Not all of Kris's order has been received yet. Kris is checking on an ETA.
 - The baseballs needed to be substituted as the Champ Pros were not available. Tee balls were substituted as well.
- Because of the cost of baseballs and the rule change to supply two game balls per game, we will need to instruct coaches to take care of baseballs & clean/reuse for games.
- o Bands and bags are ordered. They will be given to coaches for pregame/pre-practice stretches.
- Equipment handout and choosing fields/practice nights will be 3/10 from 6pm 7pm

Player Agent/Player Development Director, submitted by Kris Phagan:

- Jon K sent all info to 8U coaches.
- o Kris will be sending out 10U and 12U info to coaches by Wednesday or Thursday of this week.
 - Still working on one final coach Josh Kampes
- o Coach's clinic is scheduled for April 6 from 1pm 3pm. We will be focusing on
 - Philosophy and Q&A
 - Handbook and expectations
 - Bands and any new equipment (like the pitching pockets)
 - Rule changes
- o 14U+ evals scheduled for 3/23 with a rain date of 3/30. Hoping to use the HS field but will use Stoverstown as a backup.
 - Using men's league players to judge evals as a neutral party. We will need clearances on file before evals for all evaluators.
- Still working on a tournament list

Communications Director, submitted by Jenn Bankert:

• With lots of events in the coming weeks and months, we are planning to send out a weekly newsletter with all important information.

Fields and Grounds Director, submitted by Damian Sipe:

- Summit (with York Revs)
 - All rec teams present no travel ball teams
 - York county is rated 3.5/10. How do we improve?
 - 5 year plan and committee to work with organizations and schools
- Tractors will be dropped off for service tomorrow (batteries, tires flat, trouble starting, etc.)
- o All permits have been submitted. There is no fee for River Rock per our agreement.
- o SG Parks and Rec will change to YMCA of the Roses. This will need to be changed with our insurance.
- Spirit wear so far 23 orders in
 - SGBA will order some items to feature at opening day and can use those items as giveaways at the golf tournament.
- North Codorus lower plugs are coming out of dirt need anchors.
 - NC township is having diamond tex delivered for both fields.
- St Rose need to sit down in person to discuss plan we would like to propose to put our money into the large field instead of the small field.
- Heidelberg SG Parks and Rec had proposed to take over managing this field. We will consider using the field again but the field is in very poor condition.
- River Rock needs a lime machine for 8U. Kate King is still working on getting a shed.
- SG high school field might need a hand drag
- o SGBA will be purchasing diamond tex for SG boro field and River Rock. Work days will be scheduled.
- A skid of lime is being donated to SGBA once again this year.
- First aid kits are being restocked and will be handed out to all coaches.

Open Forum

- Guests had questions regarding communications for 14U. It was explained that registration is still open and information will be coming in the future.
- Guests asked about information regarding clearances. Questions were answered and the process was explained.
- A suggestion was made to add our certificate of insurance to the coach's binder. All agreed this should be available upon request instead of in all binders.

- Opening day is planned for April 12 at the HS field.
 - HS Field is reserved for us
 - o Suggestion for having a gym available for a rain out location
 - Suggestion for wrist bands or squishy balls as a gift to all participants
 - National Anthem singers Tiff Hunter checking for some
 - o Plan a timed run around the bases for tee ball
 - Suggestion to have Lowes have a stand with giveaways
 - Uniform handout will take place before the ceremony plan to have coaches check in around 11:30am
 - Plan for food trucks at 11am and the ceremony to start at 12p or 12:30pm everyone to reach out to food trucks
 - Suggestions to hold a homerun derby or longest throw contest
- o Golf Tournament
 - Continue to ask for sponsors and gifts from local companies
 - Reaching out to last year's teams and will be pushing registration
 - Plan to post signs about the golf tournament at all fields.
 - Possibly use Briarwood for future events. Looking for possible dates in 2026. 2025 is booked.

- o Concessions we will continue to hold concessions at Jefferson and will begin to use Boro.
 - o We plan to have food trucks at North Codorus. Who will be coordinating this?
 - Jenn B reaching to Fritolay for donations
 - April G reaching out to Martins for donations
 - Amanda R reaching out to Snyders for donations
 - We plan to assign all head coaches (8U-12U) a date for manning the concession stand at Jefferson for the men's games.
 - o We will need a sign up sheet and date for drop off for donations from our families.
- o Cupcakes by Jenn will be holding a fundraiser weekend like last year. Thank you!
